DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES

Spend half a day at the circuit on this course and you will experience the excitement of driving two of Maserati's most powerful models around a motor racing circuit: the Ghibli Trofeo and the Levante Trofeo, both powered by a 580bhp turbocharged V8 engine.

With the support of a professional team of instructors, you will learn how to master the car and enhance your driving skills in a safe and structured environment.

The hot lap onboard the pure racer GranTurismo MC GT4, driven in race mode by a professional driver, will close your day on track.

For an immersive Maserati experience, the extended program Engine Start +, only available at the circuit Autodromo di Modena, gives the chance to visit the historic Maserati car's collection and to get a guided tour of the factory in Modena (*), where the new supercar MC20 is assembled.

PROGRAM

09.30am Welcome to the Maserati Showroom in Modena

Registration of participants at the Reception and introduction to Maserati.

Guided tour of the plant facilities:

- Assembly lines of MC20 (*)
- Engine assembly workshop
- Painting workshop

11:00am Move to the Panini Motor Museum (15' driving)

Visit of the historic car's collection with some of the rarest vintage Maserati

12.45pm Move to the Autodromo di Modena (10' driving)

Buffet lunch at the circuit lounge

1.45pm Essential theory session focused on:

- Driving seat position and correct use of the car's controls
- Racing lines
- Braking procedures
- Visual targeting

2.30pm Start of dynamic activities: warm up sessions

Demonstration lap with a professional driver, followed by each participant's first driving session. Circuit familiarization: braking zones, racing lines, points of acceleration out of corners.

3.15pm Split of participants into 3 groups. To minimize waiting time, activities take place on a rotational basis.

Three driving sessions per driver, with onboard video recording for later analysis. This allows the instructor to monitor how well the exercises have been carried out and to evaluate the participant's progress.

Power oversteering on a low-grip surface: after a demonstration by the instructor, each participant learns the art of skid control on a wet oval course without the use of electronic aids.

Hot laps onboard the GranTurismo MC GT4, driven by a professional driver: two thrilling laps in a pure race car give the participant the ultimate insight into the car's awesome racetrack performance.

6.15pm End of dynamic activities: farewell and certificates ceremony
