

MASERATI DRIVING EXPERIENCE



After this full-day course, you will be amazed to see your confidence growth after each track session.

The course includes theoretical and driving sessions with Maserati's top performing models: the Ghibli Trofeo and Levante Trofeo and the MC20 supercar, equipped with the 630 HP 3-litre Nettuno twin-turbo V6 (driven in SPORT mode only).

Throughout the day, you will be supported by a team of professional instructors who will analyse your performance and allow you to fine-tune your driving technique.







8.45am Welcome to the track and registration of participants.

Theory session focused on:

- Driving seat position and correct use of the car's controls
- Racing lines
- Braking procedures
- Visual targeting
- 9.30am Start of dynamic activities: warm-up sessions.

Demonstration lap with a professional driver, followed by the first driving session for participants to familiarize themselves with the circuit: braking zones, racing lines through corners, points of acceleration.

10.30am Split of participants in groups. To minimize waiting time, activities take place on a rotational basis.

Two driving sessions per driver, with onboard video recording for later analysis. This allows the instructor to monitor how well the exercises have been carried out and evaluate the participant's progress.

Emergency braking: Simulation of hard braking at high speed on a normal road. This skill-ranking exercise uses a timing system to evaluate the individual's driving technique, reactions and precision.

Power oversteering on a low-grip surface: after a demonstration by the instructor, each participant learns the art of skid control on a wet oval course without the use of electronic aids.

Two driving sessions on the track; in the second session, data is collected for the Telemetry Race Contest via a professional onboard data acquisition system that monitors the driver's performance in terms of steering angles, braking pressure, lap times and racing lines. These will go towards the final ranking, which will be determined by the participant's overall driving technique and expertise.

Two driving sessions onboard the sensational MC20.

- Session 1: Introduction to the supercar
- Session 2: Explore the car's performance and handling in SPORT mode
- 1.30pm Buffet lunch at the circuit restaurant
- 2.30pm Dynamic activities resume
- 5.30pm End of dynamic activities: farewell, certificates and awards ceremony
