An endlessly progressive spirit

Back in 1900, one of the Maserati brothers – Carlo designed and built his first single-cylinder engine and named it ‘Carcano’. The dauntless 17-year-old then fitted it to a bicycle and entered a race. This was the hard-riding, long-distance Brescia-Cremona-Mantua-Verona-Brescia rally. Carlo won. Soon after, Carlo designed another engine. This time he mounted it in a wooden car chassis – a move that some say created the world’s first Maserati vehicle. The wheels of luxury grand touring were well and truly in motion. **In 1926**, another brother – Alfieri drove the Maserati Tipo 26 to victory in its first ever race – the treacherous Targa Florio in the mountains of Sicily.

In 1939, Wilburn Shaw won the Indianapolis 500 at the wheel of the Maserati ‘Boyle Special’ 8 CTF at an average speed of over 185km/h. The next year he won again, making Maserati the only European manufacturer to win the Indy 500 twice.

Our indomitable approach took a decidedly luxurious turn **in 1947** when Maserati created the A6 1500, built in Modena and featuring sensuous Pininfarina coachwork. The convertible sibling followed **in 1950**, in the beguiling form of the A6G Frua Spyder. The stage for the GranTurismo of today was set. **And in 1957**, the legendary Juan Manuel Fangio took his fifth F1 World Championship at the Nürburgring– also known as the Green Hell – in a Maserati 250F.





Fast forward to the turn of the century. The dawn of the **new millennium** saw Maserati's great comeback. This decade also marked an age of new opportunities in a fast and connected world. **In 2007**, Maserati revealed another 'instant classic' designed by PininFarina: the **GranTurismo** that is recognizable today.

And thus, **the all-new GranTurismo** captures everything that embodies grand touring to Maserati. With roots firmly planted in the future, its radical innovation is a testament to the principle that evolution has remained constant since day one.

Because icons aren't born overnight.

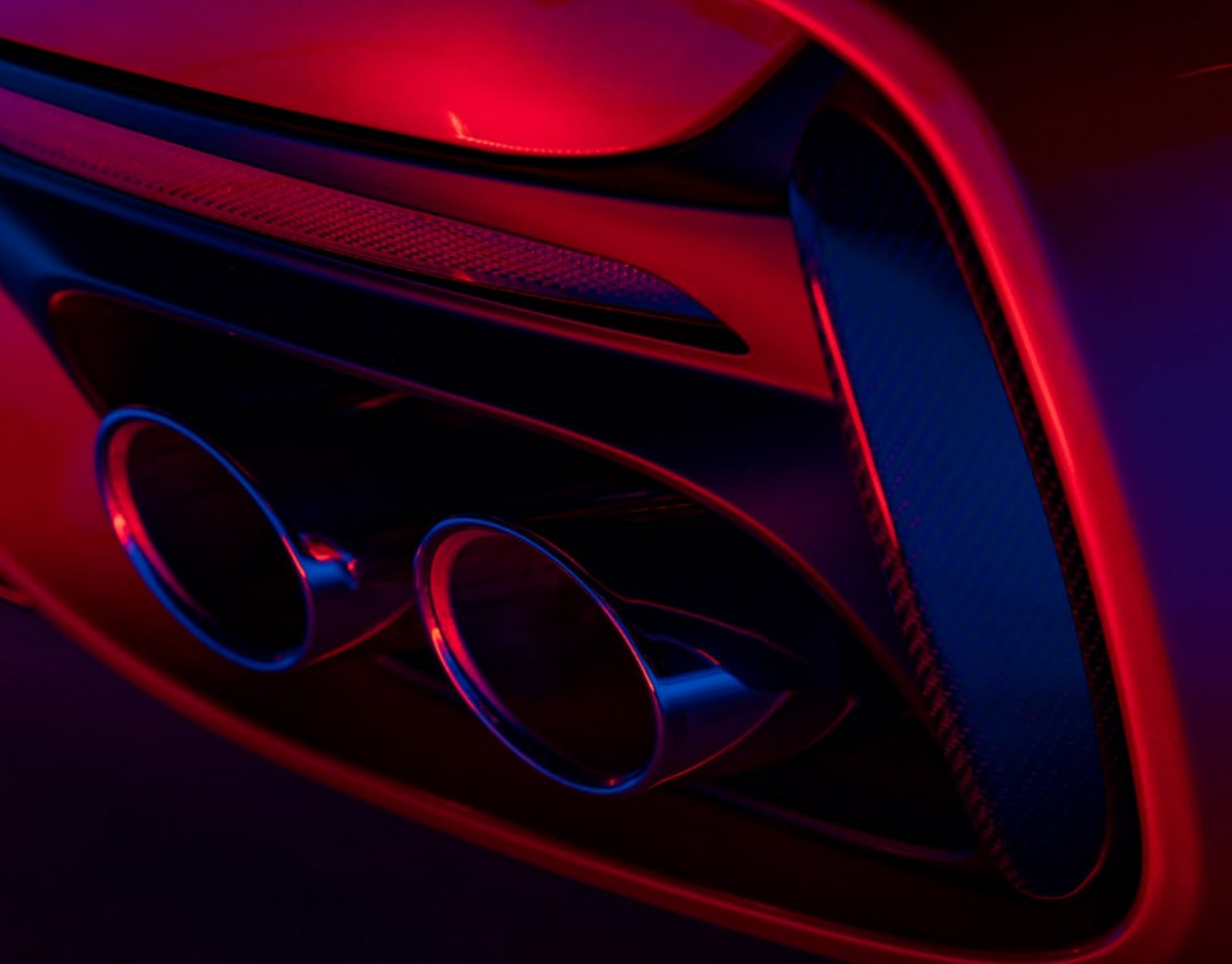

The Forged 20"/ 21" wheels with glossy black finish combined with red Brembo calipers complete the awe-inspiring view.

From the circuits to the roads The best from Formula E

The Folgore's powertrain is developed with Formula E-derived technical solutions like the silicon carbide inverters for a better energy flow and higher efficiency.

The cutting-edge 800-volt battery powers three potent 300-kw permanent magnet motors - one in the front, two in the rear - to deliver up to 560 kW 751 HP and a mind-blowing 995 lb-ft of torque across all four wheels.





Charged for a grand tour

Range 369 km

Grand touring is meant to be, well, grand. That's why one can expect to travel as far as their heart desires: up to 369 km on one battery charge. Or until the next stop for admiring the scenery. When it's time, it can charge up to 100 km in just 5 minutes - elegantly preserving that balance between going the distance fast and living at your own pace. Back on the road, additional energy is captured and stored when braking.

Lightning quick

0-100 km/h in 2.7 sec

Folgore is the Italian word for lightning, in other words, power in its purest form.

The GranTurismo Folgore flashes from 0 to 100 km/h in just 2.7 seconds and reaches a top speed of 320 km/h. The ingenious “T-bone” layout positions battery mass closer to the roll axes for a perfect weight distribution and low center of gravity – it sits at just 1.353 m high. The result? Higher speed, blazing acceleration and sensational agility: a true Maserati sports car, on its own terms.



Aerodynamic design

Its power sweeps through the air. Specific front splitters and diffusers, together with 20/21" diamond-cut gloss black Aero wheels are designed to improve Folgore's aerodynamic efficiency for a stronger and longer driving pleasure.





Drive the lightning

As soon as the destination is selected, on the central-up 12.3" screen the predicted stat of charge at destination will appear together with the best options to recharge along the journey. Charging stations and the maximum distance one can run - based on battery, driving style and roads real-time information - are displayed on the navigation map. During any stop, it's possible to keep the cabin temperature for anyone's onboard delight. Wait no more, grab the heated steering wheel and get an electrifying grand tour started.





Weaving into the future

Regeneration and circularity. To upholster seats, pillars, sun visors and the ceiling of the Folgore we used ECONYL®, a regenerated nylon fiber used to produce the technical fabric made 100% from fishing nets and others plastic scraps, already utilized in high-fashion and furniture industries.

It's like a bodysuit: compact, matte, soft-to-touch and lightweight that perfectly adapts to and breathes with the surfaces design.

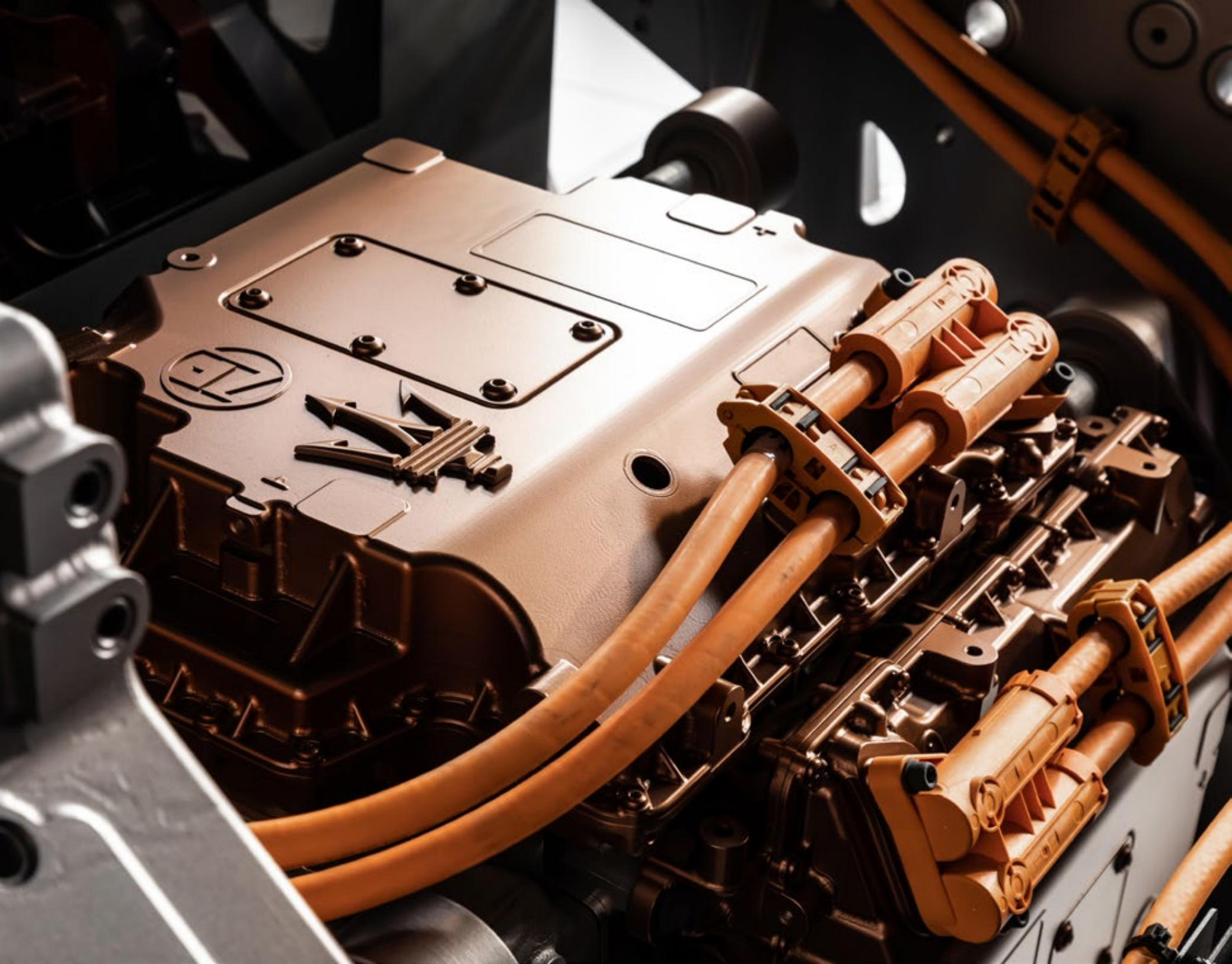

Formula E technology takes to the road in our new 100% electric powertrain. Based on 800-volt technology with three 300-kW permanent magnet motors, the Folgore system features leading-edge solutions to offer performance that feels suited to the racetrack.

Over 751 HP is continuously transmitted to the wheels due to a nominal capacity of 92.5 kWh and a discharge capacity of 560 kW. The specific battery pack layout allows the car to sit lower than any other electric vehicle, boosting acceleration and speed.

Born to race, bred for long-distances

The GranTurismo 3.0-liter twin-turbo V6 engine uses patented pre-chamber combustion technology with twin spark plugs invented to win races, now applied to get extraordinary performance with lower consumption on every road.

The ground-breaking V6 Nettuno engine, first debuted in the MC20 super sports car, is available in two versions: either the 483 hp for the GranTurismo or the higher-output 542 hp Trofeo version, which come with 8-speed automatic transmission and AWD.

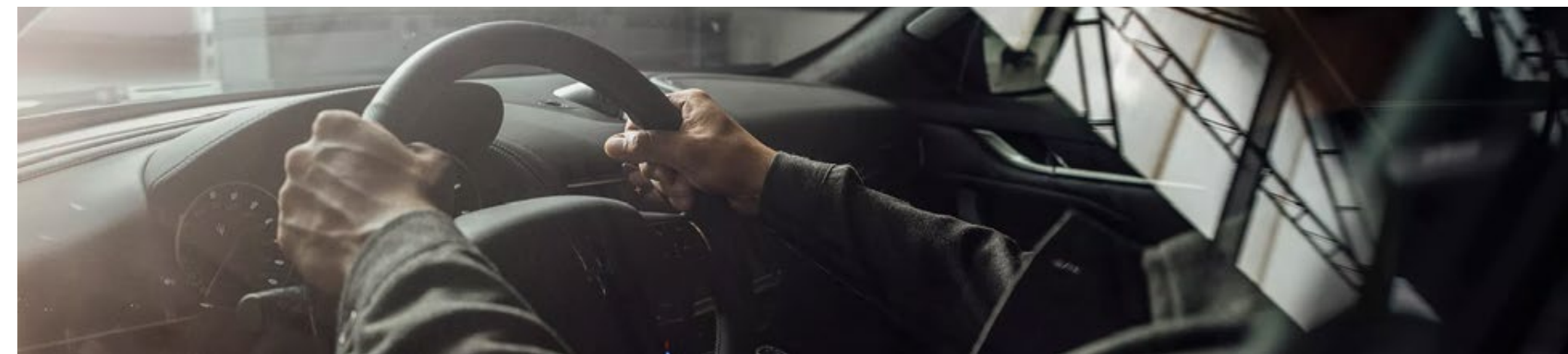
